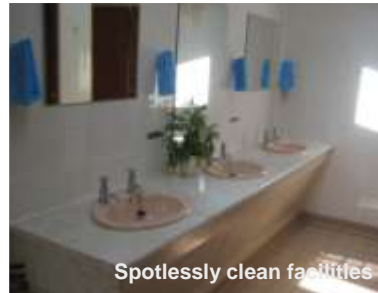

Spread over 10 acres, The Old Oaks has been beautifully landscaped to create very generous pitches separated by shrubs and trees to ensure a sense of privacy and space.

Divided into 6 individual areas, all with their own unique appeal, our park has been developed in sympathy with the environment - a fact recognised by our 10 Gold David Bellamy Conservation awards and Award of Special Distinction.

Our **super pitches** have a 6 or 7 metre level hard standing with their own grass area. Awnings, electric, drinking and waste water hook up are all inclusive.

Our generous **hard standings** with electric hook up also include a grass area.

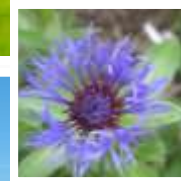
We also offer a limited number of non-electric **grass pitches** for tents.

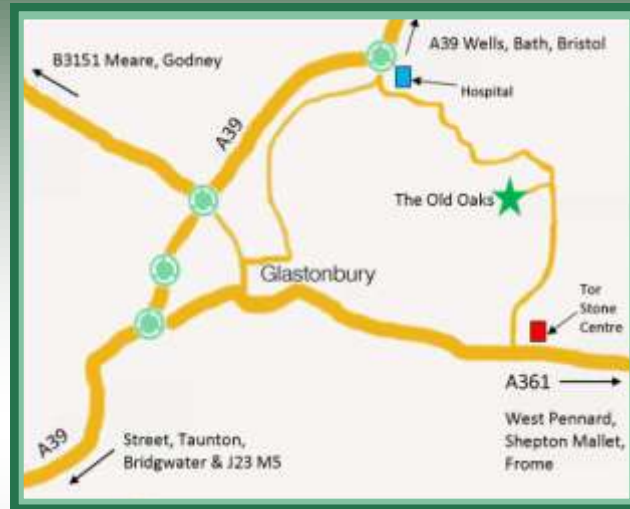

Directions

From the M5: Leave M5 at J23. Take A39 towards Glastonbury. As you approach Glastonbury take the A361 towards Shepton Mallet and Frome. Approx 1.5 miles from Glastonbury you will pass under a footbridge (next to Millfield Prep School on right). After 250 metres turn left to Wick. The park is on left in 1 mile.

From Wells / Bristol: Take A39 towards Glastonbury. Follow signs for West Mendip Hospital. Just past the hospital turn left at sign for Wick and Brindham. The park is on right in 1.5 miles.

From Shepton Mallet / Frome: Take A361 towards Glastonbury. Turn right at sign for Wick, 150 metres past Tor Stone Centre. The park is on left in 1 mile.
