

- Old Oaks does not accept any dogs on the UK banned / dangerous dogs list. From 2024 onwards, this includes XL Bullies and all part breeds of this type
- Please keep your dogs on a short lead in all areas where there are other guests. No extendable leads around the main part of the park please
- Please keep dogs tethered, within the boundaries of your own pitch
- Dogs are permitted off lead, ONLY in the 2 dog exercise areas and not on the grass areas in the central areas near pitches or The Meadow (at the bottom of Orchard area)
- If your dog is likely to bark, whine or get distressed while you're in reception / shop, please don't leave them unattended outside
- Please be vigilant when socialising on the dog walks, to ensure no unwanted gifts are left behind
- * A reminder that we are a member of Tranquil Parks and it is our obligation to provide a peaceful environment for all guests
- Prolonged or frequent periods of barking / woofing / whining is likely to impact on the relaxation and enjoyment of others so please do try to be aware of this and take the necessary actions to ensure a pleasant experience for all
- * We do completely understand that it's not always possible to predict how your dog will take to a new environment, especially if it's your pets first holiday. However it is your responsibility to ensure that other quests are not disturbed
- Dogs who show overly aggressive behaviour towards others cannot be accepted at Old Oaks
- Please only leave your pets unattended on your pitch if you are absolutely certain that they will not become distressed or cause problems for other guests
